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QUEENSLAND HOMELESSNESS INFORMATION PLATFORM

The Queensland Homelessness Information Platform (QHIP) is a secure online database that holds personal information that you have shared.

Many housing providers access the Homeless Hotline Queensland Homelessness Information Platform. They will use this database to assess your needs and match them with the most appropriate accommodation and support services. It means you only have to tell your story and share your details once.

The QHIP database is administered by the Queensland Government's Department of Housing and cannot be accessed by any other government department, but may be accessed online by other Queensland homelessness service providers in order for them to fulfil their duties to assist you. It is completely up to you how much information you share with QHIP. The information you share may influence how your housing need is seen as a priority. Your personal information will not be shared unless you say it is ok to do so.

SOCIAL HOUSING REGISTER

The Social Housing Register is a record of applications for public or community housing. Contact your nearest Department of Housing HSC to enquire about your eligibility to be considered for social or community housing or to discuss other housing options which may be available to you.

HOUSING TYPES OF ASSISTANCE

It is important to remember that as people's needs change over time, so might the housing assistance for which they are eligible. The length of time for which a person requires housing assistance is the "duration of need"

The types of housing assistance available are listed below.

EMERGENCY AND SHORT-TERM HOUSING

Emergency and short-term housing offers temporary short-term accommodation for up to three months while a more permanent housing solution is sought. Accommodation types vary by provider, as do eligibility criteria, costs, and availability.

TRANSITIONAL HOUSING

Transitional housing is a form of social housing offered by community housing providers which allows people to stabilise their circumstances before moving in to longer term housing.



SOCIAL AND COMMUNITY HOUSING

The Queensland Government through the Department of Housing and not-for-profit organisations provide access to affordable housing for people on lower incomes. Eligibility may include a mix of some or all of the following:

- Social housing (including Indigenous Housing and Homelessness programs) –rental for low to moderate income families and individuals
- Community housing those with low incomes providing income based rental accommodation
- Affordable housing those with a moderate income who are in housing stress

RESIDENTIAL SERVICES: Including Rooming Accommodation, Boarding Houses, Rentals For Seniors, Supported Accommodation.

If you pay rent for a room and share facilities, such as a kitchen, bathroom, dining room or common room, this is called rooming or residential accommodation. There are several types of residential services you can consider when looking for a place to live. These include:

- · Boarding housing usually accommodation only
- · Rentals for seniors (known as aged rentals) these usually include meals
- Supported accommodation includes food and personal care services for people with particular needs.

The Public Register of Residential Services can be accessed through the Department of Housing at www.housing.qld.gov.au and lists the locations of residential services, boarding houses, aged rentals and supported accommodation that are registered with the Department.

TEMPORARY ACCOMMODATION / HOLIDAY LETTING

Some accommodation such as hotel/motels are considered holiday letting (even if you're not on holiday) and you will have different rights to a tenancy if you are staying there. Long term stays in a caravan park may be covered under the Residential Tenancies and Rooming Accommodation Act.

Accommodation may be charged on a nightly basis and some accommodation (such as hostels) may require identity papers such as a passport. Enquire before arrival to ensure you will be able to stay.

PRIVATE RENTING AND TENANCY ASSISTANCE

The Department of Housing provides a number of ways to assist people in the private rental market, including the RentConnect service, financial assistance with renting, bond loans and rental grants, rental security subsidy and No Interest Loans Scheme (NILS) housing loans. Housing Service Centres may also be able to provide advice regarding securing private rental properties. Contact your nearest Housing Service Centre for more information (refer page 10)


